Before typing anything, format the paper for double spacing (format, paragraph, line spacing: double). Then type the MLA heading on the first four lines: your name, teacher name, class name, and date. This heading goes on the first page only.

Create a header (View, Header and Footer) that includes your last name and the page number. Type your name, then click on "Insert Page #". This will put it on every page in the proper place and with the correct page number. Highlight the text and left justify using the button on the toolbar next to the centering button.

Title: No underline, no bold, no huge font, no quotation marks, no italics.

Additional Guidelines for MLA Formatting

- Type your paper on a computer and print it out on standard, white 8.5 x 11-inch paper,
- Double-space the text of your paper, and use a legible font like Times New Roman or Courier. The font size should be 10-12 pt.
- Leave only one space after periods or other punctuation marks (unless otherwise instructed by your instructor).
- Set the margins of your document to 1 inch on all sides. Indent the first line of a paragraph one half-inch (five spaces or press tab once) from the left margin.
- Create a header that numbers all pages consecutively in the upper right-hand corner, one-half inch from the top and flush with the right margin. (Note: Your instructor may ask that you omit the number on your first page. Always follow your instructor's guidelines.)
- Use either italics or underlining throughout your essay for the titles of longer works and, only when absolutely necessary, providing emphasis.
- If you have any endnotes, include them on a separate page before your Works Cited page.
- Do not make a title page for your paper unless specifically requested.
